### **Rebuilding the Cape Cod Rail Trail**

The Cape Cod Rail Trail is one of the oldest rail trails in the country. After 25 years of use by millions of visitors, the trail is showing its age. With the endorsement of Governor Romney, the Department of Conservation and Recreation evaluated this 22-mile corridor and developed a \$6.2 million rehabilitation program, which is currently underway. Hear why some sections of the trail are in pretty good condition and why other sections had nicknames like “anaconda” and “rattler.’ Lessons learned from this project will not only help you develop strategies to improve an existing trail, but will also assist those who are developing new trails. Come review and participate in discussions of intersection treatments, vegetation and root barrier issues, trail counting mechanisms, and more.
