The U.S. Department of Energy's Waterpower Program has awarded a grant to the Hydro Research Foundation to support the Research Awards Program. Research Awards will begin as early as June 2015 and will be for one-year research projects. Approximately 15 awards will be made which include a living stipend, tuition allowance, an allowance for university-provided health insurance, a contribution to the student's advisor's discretionary fund and for the student's attendance at two annual Research Roundtables.

Full-time students who are attending US Universities are eligible to apply. Applications are accepted from students who will be conducting research directly related to conventional and pumped-storage hydropower in the fields of electrical, mechanical, control-systems engineering, environmental and biological science, regulatory/economics, among other fields of research. The goal of the Research Awards Program is to attract graduate level students and research to the hydropower industry.
