Postdoctoral Position in Bioengineering

Candidates are sought for an immediate postdoctoral opening in the group of Prof. Neil Forbes. The ideal candidate will have a PhD in Chemical Engineering, Bioengineering, Molecular Biology, Cancer Biology or a related field. Expertise in molecular biology is strongly encouraged. The research focus is engineering targeted bacteria to be anticancer therapeutics, work supported by the National Institutes of Health. Candidates should have a strong background in experimental techniques, excellent oral and written communication skills, and the ability to work in an interdisciplinary environment. The laboratory of Prof. Forbes is located in a new building with state of the art facilities for bioengineering research. Small animal research will be performed in a new facility at Baystate Medical Center.
